Kemira reports according to the Corporate Sustainability Reporting Directive (CSRD) requirements, which aim to enhance transparency, accountability and comparability in sustainability reporting across the EU. The CSRD is aligned with the EU's objective to achieve climate neutrality by 2050 and to elevate sustainability reporting, environment, social and governance, to a level of importance equal to financial reporting. The CSRD builds upon the foundation of the Non-Financial Reporting Directive and also expands the scope of reporting obligations on companies operating within the EU. Kemira continues to compile a Global Reporting Initiative (GRI) index to enhance visibility and, interests and needs of stakeholders.
